## \*Pension Obligation Bonds (POB)

In FY 08, bond proceeds amounting to \$2 billion were deposited into the fund, in addition to the normal state contribution. PA 07-186, AAC Adequate Funding of the Teachers' Retirement System authorized state general obligation bonds to fund \$2 billion of the unfunded liability of the Teachers' Retirement System and requires the state to make the full actuarial required contribution for the 25-year term of the POB.

## **Teachers' Contribution (7% pension)**

PA 17-2 JSS increased by one percentage point, from 6% to 7%, the contribution made by teachers toward their TRS pension, effective January 1, 2018.

## Social Security/Medicare

TRS members do not pay the Social Security tax (6.2%) on earnings as a teacher, or administrator, but do pay 1.45% towards Medicare.

Note: TRS members also contribute 1.25% of salary for TRS retiree health insurance fund.
